



Research Award of the Leibniz Alliance “Bioactives and Biotechnology”

The Leibniz Research Alliance “Bioactive Compounds and Biotechnology” calls for applications for its 2020 research award. The award honors outstanding scientific personalities active in a research topic covered by the Alliance. A formal connection or cooperation with a member of the Leibniz Association or the Alliance is not required but valued. The prize includes € 2,000 prize money, a Leibniz medal, a certificate, and an invitation to the conference “Leibniz-Wirkstofftage” 12-13. April 2021 in Hamburg, Germany, covering travel expenses.

Nominations can be submitted by any active principal investigator of a Leibniz Institute. They should include – in English language – ca. one page highlighting the merits of the nominee, preferably relating them to an extraordinary achievement that did not receive a prize previously. Full contact details, a CV, and ideally pdfs of key publications or patents should be provided. Self-applications are not possible. The nominee should be asked for consent prior to suggesting her/his name. The laureate is expected to present his/her research on the upcoming “Leibniz-Wirkstofftage” (s. above) and be willing to participate in a press event or similar PR activities.
