



Research Award of the Leibniz Research Network “Bioactives”

The Leibniz Research Network “Bioactive Compounds” calls for applications for its 2026 research award. The award honors outstanding scientific personalities active in a research topic covered by the Network. A formal connection or cooperation with a member of the Leibniz Association or the Network is not required but valued. The prize includes € 2,000 prize money, a Leibniz medal, a certificate, and an invitation to the conference “Leibniz-Wirkstofftage” in spring 2026 in Aachen, Germany, covering travel expenses.

Application deadline: 05. January 2026

Nominations can be submitted by any active principal investigator of a Leibniz Institute. They should include – in English language – ca. one page highlighting the merits of the nominee, preferably relating them to an extraordinary achievement that did not receive a prize previously. Full contact details, a CV, and ideally pdfs of key publications or patents should be provided. Self-applications are not possible. The nominee should be asked for consent prior to suggesting her/his name. The laureate is expected to present his/her research on the upcoming “Leibniz-Wirkstofftage” (s. above) and be willing to participate in a press event or similar PR activities.
